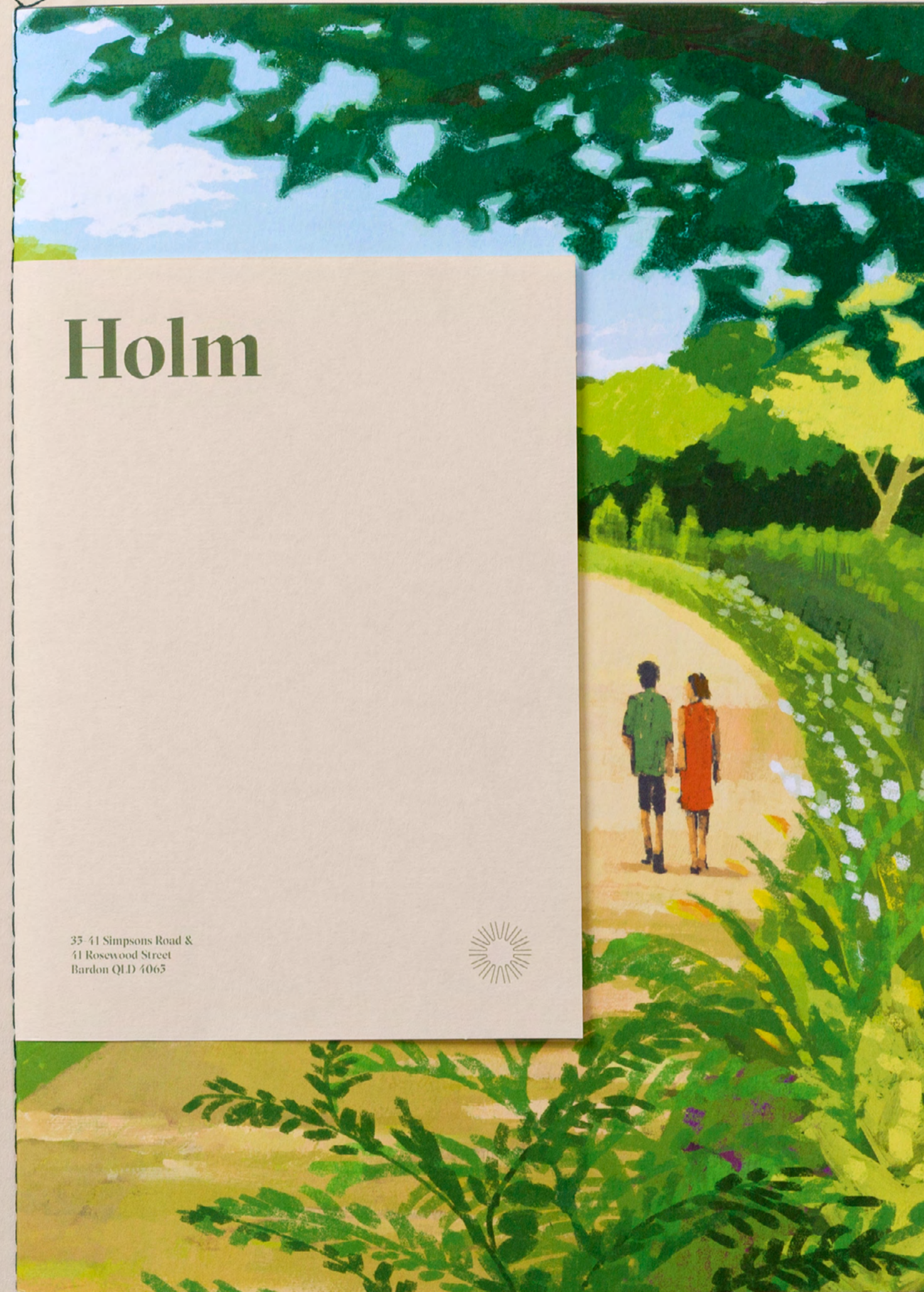

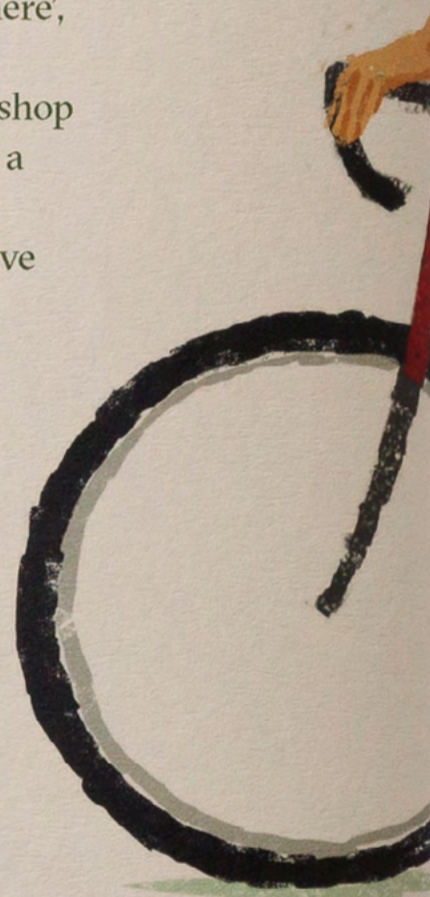

"Conveniently located between two street frontages - Simpsons Rd and Rosewood St, these terraced residences take full advantage of their elevated site to provide contemporary private residences with views down into the Bardon valley.

Stepping down the site maximises views from all levels and the homes incorporate spacious living areas opening out to elevated outdoor decks and private courtyards, taking full advantage of the northern aspect."
